


Business architecture value streams differ from high-level processes, value chains, Lean value streams, and SAFe value stream.

## AN OVERVIEW OF BUSINESS ARCHITECTURE VALUE STREAMS

They are high level, flexible, state-based frameworks intended for framing challenges and opportunities, solutions and initiatives

They do create value for an external or internal stakeholder, and are grounded in the context of an organization's entire ecosystem

They are abstractions which cross business units and products

They are typically fewer in quantity (e.g., ~24+ value streams)

They are architecturally sound and form the foundation of an organization's business architecture together with capabilities

X	They are not detailed structures intended to the business
X	They do not represent an internally-centric
	They are not detailed representations for sp units, products or other silos
X	They are not voluminous and ever-growing a organization
